HOW IT WORKS

- 1: Design your artwork. Open to all ages.**
- 2: Submit your work by emailing a photo of your piece to the Carrollton Center for the Arts. All media are welcome.**
- 3: All entries will be exhibited at the center during the holiday season.**
- 4: One work will be selected by a judge to be turned into a special holiday card. The original artwork will be purchased by the Carrollton Center for the Arts for their permanent collection.**

2020 SEASON'S GREETINGS ART AND DESIGN CONTEST

BASIC INFORMATION AND SUBMISSION PROCESS

1: Design your artwork. All mediums accepted, but the winning artwork will be based on its merit as a two-dimensional holiday card design. (Three-dimensional media, if chosen, will be photographed for the card's image.)

2: Submit your work. Send in a digital photograph of your finished piece to mkuykendall@carrollton-ga.gov by September 21. Include a filled-out submission form in the email. Submitted images will be used by the judge to select a winning piece of art.

3: The winning artwork will be purchased (for up to \$100) by the Carrollton Center for the Arts for its permanent collection. The artwork will also be turned into a holiday card and shared by the center during the holiday season. *All artwork must be \$100 or less in value.*

4: All artwork will also be exhibited at the center in November and December. Physical artwork must be delivered to the center by October 26 to be a part of the exhibit. The artwork may be for sale to the public with the exception of the winning artwork.

ARTWORK ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Only one work may be submitted by each artist. Artists must live within Carroll County. There is no cost to submit to the contest.
- Digital images must be sent as jpegs and must portray the entered artwork accurately and clearly. Submitted images must be clear and large enough to easily see the artwork. NO DIGITAL EDITING ALLOWED, unless the original work is a digital photograph or illustration. *Digital works must be printed for the exhibit. Same guidelines for hanging and installation applies.*
 - The winning artwork selected for the holiday card will be professionally photographed or scanned. This work will need to be turned into the center after the selection notification to provide time to photograph the work and print the cards.
 - *This excludes digital photographs and illustrations, which will be used in their original format. For these artworks, a print quality version of the work (at least 300 dpi) will need to be sent if chosen for the card design.*
- For the exhibition, unframed paper works by children will be hung by clips. All other artwork should be framed or gallery wrapped and wired for hanging with any special display instructions clearly noted at the time of entry. Hangers or wires must be large enough to hold 1/2 inch hooks, which are used by the center's installation system.
- Work must have been created in the last 2 years and not previously shown by the center.
- All artwork must be original works (not created from images, logos or photographs not owned by the artist) and cannot be giclee copies of original work (such as paintings, drawings, etc.)
- Artwork must be able to be viewed by all ages.

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Physical Artwork Delivery Date (for the exhibition): October 26 from 11 am to 4 pm (The winning work will have an earlier delivery date so that cards may be printed in time for the show.)

Holiday Card Exhibition Dates: November 5 – December 13

Reception & Holiday Card Presentation: November 5, 5 pm – 7 pm.

Pick-up of Selected Artwork: December 14, 2020 between 11 am to 4 pm

If for some reason an artist is unable to pick up their work during this time, arrangements will need to be made with the Art Center staff. The Carrollton Center for the Arts does not have adequate storage to keep artwork for long periods of time. Therefore, any artwork left after the allotted time for pick up will no longer become the responsibility of the staff.

- The Carrollton Center for the Arts will insure and protect exhibited works against fire, theft, and vandalism from the date and time of receipt until the date the show ends; for the value listed above. Although care is taken to safeguard the work, the Carrollton Center for the Arts is not liable for nicks, dents, scratches, and/or other minor breakage.
- Permission is given to reproduce the artwork for publicity purposes and the printing of holiday cards to be used by the Carrollton Center for the Arts to raise funds for its educational programming.
- Checks and credit card payment for purchase of artwork in the exhibition shall be made out to the City of Carrollton. If the artwork is sold, Carrollton Center for the Arts **will retain a 20% commission on all artwork sold. The artist will receive 80% of personal sales.** At the close of the exhibition, the City of Carrollton will mail artist(s) that have sold work a check no later than five weeks after the close of the exhibition.
