NOTES FOR PEACE EXHIBIT & CONTEST GUIDELINES & INFORMATION

The Carrollton Center for the Arts will be celebrating the installation of its new Peace Pole with a very special art contest and exhibition. To promote the idea of peace, the center is asking local artists, writers, organizations, and community members to create a piece of artwork, poem, story, or other writing about what peace means to them. The challenge is that each work will be created on a Post-It note. The works will be exhibited during Art Takeover and may also be included in a digital album to be shared online. A few selected artworks and writings will be chosen to be turned into banners for the community.

ART TAKEOVER and NOTES FOR PEACE EXHIBIT: THURSDAY, MARCH 25 FROM 5 TO 8 PM

Guidelines:

1. Artists of all ages are welcome to submit artwork.
2. Each artist/writer will receive a Post-It Note to fill and decorate as they wish. Limit 3 notes per participant. The material choice for decoration and text is up to the creator of the work. All materials should be lightweight as the notes will be installed using the adhesive on the back of the note only.
 - a. Stop by the center to pick up your blank note.
3. Works should keep to the theme: "What does peace mean to you?" All subject matter must be able to be viewed by all ages. *Mature content matter and text may not be included.*
4. **Works will be due to the arts center by March 19th.** Pieces selected to be turned into banners will be announced during the evening of Art Takeover at 5:00 pm during our Peace Pole installation celebration.
5. There will also be an opportunity to make Notes for Peace works during Takeover at the center's Creative Station. *If you would like your work to be considered for a banner design, you must turn in artwork earlier by the March 19th due date.*
6. Works of art will not be labeled, but artists are welcome to include identifying information on the front or back of their work.
7. Please keep a few extra sticky notes adhered behind your work in order to preserve the sticky adhesive.
8. Please place your artwork(s) in an envelope with your name and contact information when returning the work.
9. The exhibit's installation staff will treat each work carefully, but pieces will not be insured.
