## REGISTRATION AND FEES

WINTER/SPRING SEMESTER: OPEN JANUARY 3-20

SOME CLASSES AND PROGRAMS WILL REMAIN OPEN WHILE SPACE PERMITS.

Participants who cancel their registration prior to the beginning of a program will also receive full reimbursement, but a **20% handling fee will be assessed to cover our costs. NO REFUND** will be made after the first camp/class session.

**No refunds can be made on theater/concert tickets sold.** Hardships will be handled on an individual basis and **MUST BE** delivered in writing to the executive director. Please allow four weeks for reimbursement.
