REGISTRATION OPENS JANUARY 2–19 Some classes and programs will remain open while space permits.

Classes may be canceled if minimum participation is not reached. Participants enrolled in any instructional class, camp, workshop or special event that is canceled by the Carrollton Center for the Arts will receive a full refund or may transfer the registration fee to another class being offered during that semester.

Participants who cancel their registration prior to the beginning of a program will also receive full reimbursement, but a **20% handling fee** will be assessed to cover our costs. **NO REFUND** will be made after the first camp/class session.

Dance Bundle Discount: Eligible classes may be combined with a classical ballet class for a 20% discount. May also be combined with eligible acting classes. You **MUST CALL** to register bundles. Youth dance classes excluded. May be combined with other discounts.

All class days and/or times are subject to change. The Carrollton Center for the Arts reserves the right to cancel and/or combine classes based on enrollment.

No refunds on theatre/concert tickets. Hardships will be handled on an individual basis and **MUST BE** delivered in writing to the director. Please allow four weeks for reimbursement.
