Entries Allowed Per School: 35

An awards ceremony and reception will be held in the Art Center for all participants in the art exhibition on **Sunday, February 4, 2024 from 3 to 5 pm.** Awards will be announced around 3:45.

#### Awards:

Best of Show (\$500), First Place (\$400), Second Place (\$300) Third Place (\$200) and Fourth Place (\$100) will be awarded. Awards are provided by Kiwanis Club of Carrollton.

Judges may also elect to recognize students for honorable mention awards. These do not include scholarships. The Best of Show winner and highest winner representing each grade will be invited to bring their entry to the Kiwanis District/State Competition. District level competition includes a top prize of \$3,500. Complete details will be given to participants by a Kiwanis representative.

**NOTE:** Participants and teachers should read all guidelines carefully before submitting entries. Students in Carroll County who attend schools that do not have an art teacher or a participating art teacher, may enter on their own. Cutoff will still be 35 works per school, first come, first serve.

# KIWANIS ART AND MUSIC SHOWCASE 2024 HIGH SCHOOL ART CONTEST AND EXHIBITION GUIDELINES

Sponsored by Carrollton Center for the Arts and Kiwanis Club of Carrollton

- 1. Competition is open to any high school student in grades 9—12 attending school in Carrollton/Carroll County including private and homeschool students.
- 2. Work shown in another exhibition, such as School Arts, at the Arts Center cannot be displayed again.
- 3. ART TEACHERS: Students attending public or private school with an art teacher on staff, must submit entries through the art instructor or organizing teacher of that school. Please fill out the Label and Inventory sheets only. You do not have to fill out an application form for each student.
- 4. HOMESCHOOL & INDIVIDUAL STUDENTS who attend schools that do not have an art teacher (or participating art teacher) may enter on their own. Please fill out the homeschool and Individual application form and attach this to the back of your artwork. Cutoff will still be 35 works per school, first come, first serve.
- 5. Work must be from a single artist, not a group project.
- 6. It is recommended that two-dimensional works on paper be matted or backed with a thick paper to prevent curling and the gallery hanging clips from leaving indents on the original artwork. Please use strong tape or other method of adhesion. *Note that if a work on paper is selected as a winner and is not matted, the student may be asked to add this before the artwork is sent to the next level of competition.*
- 7. All canvas paintings must be framed or wrapped with painted edges. Frames are permissible on all artwork but are not required.
- 8. Framed and canvas work MUST use a wire or sawtooth for hanging. Frames with small holes for nails only will not be hung. Canvases without hangers or wires also may not be hung. The gallery hanging system utilizes hooks that are at least a 1/2' wide. All hangers and wires must be able to fit this. Do not use multiple hangers on any piece. All hanging hardware must be attached firmly.
- 9. Pastels and Charcoal Works must have a sealant applied to them so that they don't smear or be covered by glass or acrylic.
- 10. Sculptures must be mounted securely on a base or free standing. Sculptures that are not properly mounted or appear unstable will not be installed in the exhibition.
- 11. Limit of **two** works per student. Works larger that 48"x48" will be considered two entries with regards to the 35 entry limit per school.
- 12. All work must be dry when delivered. Wet paint, plaster, etc; is not permissible and will be disqualified for entry.
- 13. Artwork should be delivered to the Carrollton Center for the Arts—251 Alabama Street by 6:00 p.m. Friday, January 12, 2024.
- 14. Art shall remain in the Galleria during the entire exhibition.
- 15. All submissions must be the original signed work of the artist. Artwork should not be copies of another artist's work. Paintings from photographs are permissible for competition *only* if the artist is the photographer. Works that are copied from another's photograph or a magazine/tv/film subject such as celebrities, logos, cartoons and exotic wildlife can be displayed but WILL NOT be judged for award consideration. Judges and CCA staff have final say regarding what may and may not be judged.
- 16. Staff reserves the right to remove questionable work or work that is includes mature themes including nudity, erotic and macabre art. Suitability is a staff decision. Carrollton Center for the Arts staff will reject submissions that do not meet standards or adhere to the guidelines.
- 17. Artwork may be picked up on Monday, February 26 following the close of the show by 6:00 p.m. Please contact the art center if other arrangements need to be made.
